



Wisconsin Women in Higher Education Leadership Outstanding Achievement Award

Eligibility:

Nominees should be women working at an institution of higher education (UW, private, or technical) or in the public/private sector who have made significant contributions to higher education. Nominees may include women who work in any job classification (i.e., support staff, non-tenured instructor and/or researcher, faculty, administrator).

Award Criteria (one or more of the following):

- Single event that changed the working environment, leadership opportunities and/or advancement and/or inclusion of women in higher education.
- Statewide initiative that has had an impact on the status of women.
- Lifetime career that supports an improved climate and/or opportunities for women at institutions of higher education in Wisconsin.

Nomination Process:

- Nominators should provide a brief (two-page maximum) narrative outlining the nominee's accomplishments.
- Nominators should arrange for two letters of support from colleagues who were/are directly affected by the nominee's contributions.

Deadline for receipt of completed nomination package is June 1. Nomination materials should be sent to the WWHEL state president (currently Mary Oling-Sisay, Vice President of Student Affairs and Dean of Students, St. Norbert College, 100 Grant Street, De Pere, Wisconsin 54115, 920-403-3055, mary.oling-sisay@snc.edu).

The selection will be made by the WWHEL Board of Directors and announced at the recognition dinner at the fall WWHEL Conference.
